UPDATE ON CANADA STUDENT SUMMER JOBS APPLICATION

Our application was returned stating "Your application must be resubmitted because the attestation cannot be altered or modified. The "I attest" box must be checked." CCCC's & our Fellowship President have recommended us to resubmit as is, adding the following letter (in part): "Our religious beliefs and obligations, our conscience, our beliefs, thoughts, and opinions all preclude us from making the attestation as set out in the application and guide, including the supplementary information. It is for this reason that we request an accommodation of our Charter rights to freedom of religion; freedom of conscience; freedom of belief; freedom of opinion; freedom of thought; freedom of expression; and equality rights; as well as our right to not be discriminated against on the basis of religion under the Canadian Human Rights Act. We trust that you will consider the Charter and human rights accommodations we require." Please pray for our government's eyes to be opened to the Truth; for Canadian Evangelical Leaders as they consider 'next steps' if our applications are rejected; for the thousands of students, including Kurtis & Courtney, who may not receive the valuable work experience & necessary tuition funding available through this program
